Bio

National security expert, long-time special services officer and university lecturer. He began his career as a journalist, and after graduating from the University of Wrocław, he joined the Polish special services, serving both at home and abroad. He concluded his service in the Central Anti-Corruption Bureau, retiring in 2023.

After leaving the service, he became involved in the development of education in the area of security. At Nicolaus Copernicus University he created an original postgraduate program on national security and emerging new forms of strategic threats.

In February 2025, together with Gen. Maciej Materka and Col. Norbert Loba, he founded the Frontline Foundation, a think tank focused on strengthening Poland's institutional resilience and developing transatlantic relations in the context of a changing security environment.

At the Foundation, he is responsible for shaping the program's strategic direction, expert cooperation, and driving the development of educational and analytical initiatives, as well as researching and countering disinformation targeting Poland and NATO members.
